## 1. About us

We are **Hacken OÜ**, located at Kai tn 1-5M, Tallinn city, Harju county, 10111, Estonia, registration code: 14351915. From now on, Hacken OÜ will be referred to as "we" and "our."

We are the controller of your personal data, so we determine what, for what purpose and how your personal data will be processed.

## 2. About this Privacy Notice

Privacy Notice is a document, practically a statement of us as a business to you (data subject) that describes how we collect, use, retain and disclose personal data.

### 3. Personal data that we process

The data we process is divided into categories: **technical information** and data that is provided **to us** by visitors and Users.

**Technical information.** When you visit our website, some data is collected automatically. We need technical data to operate, maintain, and improve our website. This includes data such as IP address, UTM parameters, geolocation, device type, browser type and data about your interaction with the website - session ID.

**Data are provided to us** by the following data subjects:

- Visitors — all persons who visit our website.
- Users — visitors who filled our forms.

**Pay your attention.** We knowingly **do not process** the personal data of users under the age of 18 without consent from legal representative(s). If you are such a user, or you are the legal representative of the user, please let us know by email [support@hacken.io](mailto:support@hacken.io).

## 4. Period of data storage

We store **user data** during the use of our services and for 3 years afterwards.

We store **technical data (visitor data)** for up to two years.

You can exercise your right to delete your data. In this case, your data will be deleted from our servers within 30 days of your request.

## 5. Your privacy rights

You, as subjects of personal data, have the following rights:

<b>The right to access information.</b>	You can request an explanation of the processing of your personal data.
<b>The right to portability.</b>	You can request all the data that you provided to us, as well as request to transfer data to another controller.

<b>The right to restrict processing.</b>	You may partially or completely prohibit us from processing your personal data.
<b>The right to file complaints.</b>	If your request was not satisfied, you can file a complaint to the regulatory body.
<b>The right to be forgotten.</b>	You can send us a request to delete your personal data from our systems, unless there is a legal requirement to keep it.
<b>The right to withdraw consent.</b>	For data that you have previously consented to, you can always withdraw your consent and we will stop processing it.

## 6. Sharing data with third parties

We use your personal data to perform a contract and for communication between us and the user. We use and transfer your personal data in measures which are needed to perform a contract. Also, we transfer your data on the following grounds:

**Consent.** We transfer your personal data based on your explicit consent.

**Compliance with the law.** We will disclose your personal data to third parties to the extent that it is necessary:

- to comply with a government request, court order, or applicable law;
- to prevent unlawful use of our website or violation of the Terms of Use of our website and our policies;

- to protect against claims of third parties;
- to help prevent or investigate fraud.

**Transfer to third parties:** We transfer your personal data to third parties on the basis of a public offer for processing on our behalf, subject to technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data.

## 7. Transfer of data outside the European Economic Area

The personal data we collect is stored on our servers in Google Cloud. By default, the data is processed in Ukraine/Estonia, but we may need to process your personal data in another country.
